ANTI-EROSION TECHNOLOGIES: TRANSITION BETWEEN TRADITION AND INNOVATION

Claudio Zarotti, founder, Managing Director and Chairman of “PRATI ARMATI Srl” (a company dedicated to research in Bioengineering and Environmental Technology), is one of the world’s leading experts in the application of green technologies to erosion control and environmental recovery. Mr Zarotti is a founding member and director of various industrial research companies dedicated to projects of technological product and process innovation for globally leading industrial groups (Whirlpool, Nestlè, Barilla, General Electric, Enel, TecnoSpazio, Pirelli, Bassetti, Artemide, etc..) He is the author of ten patents, with worldwide application in the fields of physics, materials engineering, new products and processes and has published various articles in international scientific journals. Among the awards he has received is the Certificate of Technical Excellence – First Class, issued by Vetiver Network (a body of the World Bank), an international organisation promoted by the World Bank, by the US National Research Council and by university research institutes from over one hundred countries.
